VOLUNTEERS under Act 153

If a volunteer has continuously resided in Pennsylvania for ten (10) years and swears in writing that he or she has never been convicted of a disqualifying crime in Pennsylvania or the corresponding offenses under the laws of any other jurisdiction, the volunteer only need the Department of Human Services PA Child Abuse History Clearance (Act 151) and the PA State Police Criminal History Records Check (Act 34). The FBI Federal Criminal History Record (Act 114) is not needed.

This document must be completed and notarized in place of the FBI Federal Criminal History Record (fingerprints) if qualified as above. The applicant has two options:

1. Make an appointment with Janet Gregor at the Administration Office (phone number above – ext. 5453) and the affidavit will be notarized by the School District at no cost. (You must bring current government-issued photo ID – driver’s license or passport.)
OR
2. Take this affidavit to the Notary of your choice for completion.

I do further swear and affirm that I am not disqualified from service pursuant to section 6344(c) of the Child Protective Services Law or have not been convicted of an offense similar in nature to those crimes listed in section 6344(c) of the Child Protective Services Law under the laws or former laws of the United States or one of its territories or possessions, another state, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico or a foreign nation, or under a former law of this Commonwealth.
