RoboBots Team Earns Awards

On April 7th 2018 the Union City Battle Bot Team, Wreckless Endangerment traveled to Meadville for the regional tournament. The competition involved 22 schools and 45 teams. The team has worked since last November to fabricate two battlebots, "Fuhrer" with a lift arm weapon and "Immortalizer" our famous double sided wedge. This was a double elimination tournament. The team worked and battled hard all day and in the end, Fuhrer earned a 13th place finish winning 3 matches and Immortalizer earned a 3rd place finish winning 5. Also, Immortalizer was awarded the prestigious "King of the Ring" by the judges for putting on the best show. The team added two more trophies to the Union City Trophy case. In the 8 years the team has competed, they have brought 5 trophies home to Union City.
