The Union City Lady Bears Volleyball team won their first match last night against Conneaut Valley. Scores were 25-22, 25-19, 19-25, and 25-16. Top scorers for Varsity were Megan Kimmy with 7 kills and 8 digs, Shelby Glenn with 11 points and 3 aces, 17 assists and 10 digs, MacKenzie Gilson with 18 digs, Rashel Gilson with 8 points and 6 aces, 5 kills and 17 digs, and MacKenzie Dougherty with 4 kills. Junior Varsity also won their match. The scores of that match was 22-25, 25-7, and 15-9. Top scorers for JV were Halle Hinkle with 18 points and 4 aces, 2 assists and 25 digs, Nikki Adams with 3 aces and 2 kills, and Kassandra Vazquez with 8 points.
